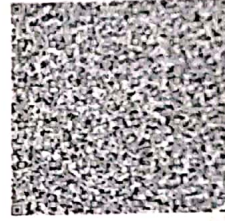

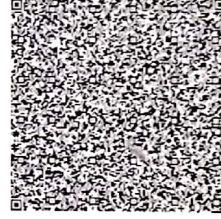

AND

(1) **LIPIKA GAYEN (PAN - BIYPG9547H) (AADHAAR NO - 8628 7467 4026)**, daughter of Sri Gunadhar Gayen by faith - Hindu, by occupation - Business, by Nationality and Citizenship - Indian at present residing at Kumirmari, Goshaba, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal- 743378, West Bengal, India, hereinafter called and referred to as the "**SECOND PARTY**" and/or "**FOUNDER TRUSTEE**" of the said Trust, and (2) **SUSHIL GHORAI (PAN - AFCPG7788N) (AADHAAR NO- 7413 8668 1265)**, Son of Late Kartick Chandra Ghorai, aged about 62 years, by faith - Hindu, by occupation - Business, by Nationality and Citizenship - Indian, residing at Chiranjibpur, Haldia, Post Office - Chiranjibpur, P.S- Chiranjibpur, Haldia Pin - 721604, West Bengal, India, hereinafter called and referred to as the "**THIRD PARTY**" and/or "**FOUNDER TRUSTEE**" of the said Trust (which terms and/or expressions shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject and/or context be deemed to mean and include each of their legal

heirs, successors, executors, administrators, representatives, and assigns etc.), both together of the "**OTHER PART**".

WHEREAS:

A. The AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein is desirous to create the said Trust under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882, exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning under the Income Tax Act, 1961 and in particular for arranging resources to satisfy objects of the said Trust which are hereinafter appearing and for performing the said activities which are more fully and particularly mentioned in this Deed of Trust. ✓

B. To such end, the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein is now setting up the said Trust by this Deed of Trust with such objects and on such terms as stated hereinafter. ✓

C. The AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein wishes to make an initial contribution of **Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only)** to the said Trust funds to the Trustees herein in accordance with the terms hereunder as an initial contribution to the said Trust funds.

D. The Trustees herein above-named have agreed to act as the Trustees of the said Trust and to hold the said sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) only and the investment for the time being representing the same and all other sums or properties that may from time to time form the part of the said Trust funds and upon the said Trust hereafter declared of and/or concerning the same. ✓

E. The said Trust formed hereby will be a Public Charitable Trust and will work for charitable purposes for the general public at large irrespective of any religion, caste, creed, and social status, etc., and for the mankind, animals, plants, and environment, etc.

F. The **FOUNDER TRUSTEE(S)** herein above-named shall be the **LIFETIME TRUSTEE(S)** of the said Trust.

G. In view of the above, the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein and the Trustees herein are hereby agree and confirm the followings:

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In these presents the following expressions have, where the context permits, the following meanings respectively:

1.1. **"AUTHOR/SETTLOR"** means **SRI PUKAL MISTRY [PAN-BOKPM8049E]** son of Sri Sukumar Mistri by faith – Hindu, by occupation – Business, by Nationality and Citizenship – Indian residing at Chhota Sehra, Uttar Para, P.S- Chotta Sehara, North Twenty Four Parganas, West Bengal and include his legal heirs, successors, executors, administrators, representatives, and assigns etc.

1.2. **"TRUST"** means **"ZYCON FOUNDATION"** which will be a Public Non-Profitable, Non-Commercial and Charitable Trust.

1.3. **"TRUSTEES"** means the Founder Trustees and other Trustee or Trustees, who thereafter will be appointed as Trustee(s) of the said Trust, for the time being.

1.4. **"TRUST FUND"** means the said sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) only and all properties at any time added thereto by way of purchase, further settlements, gifts, donations, acquisitions, accumulations of income and capital accretions or otherwise and all properties movable or immovable from time to time belonging to or owned by the said Trust.

1.5. “**OBJECTS**” mean the objects of the said Trust for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

1.6. Wherever the male gender or pronoun presently appears in this Deed, it shall be interpreted to mean both male and female persons.

2. SETTLEMENT

2.1. For effectuating the settlement, the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein doth hereby transfers and assigns unto the Trustees all the said sum of money of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) and beneficial right or interest therein, including the investment thereof representing the same and all additions thereto, accretions thereof or the accumulated income there from and all other properties that may be acquired out of the same or may be subject to the said Trust, hereinafter referred to as the properties of the said Trust, TO HAVE AND HOLD the same in the said Trust for welfare and benefit of the beneficiaries and for the purposes and objects of the said Trust in such manner and to such extent as expressed herein.

2.2. The Trustees hereby covenant with the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein that the Trustees herein shall stand and be possessed of the said sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) and all income arising there from in or upon the said Trust subject to their powers and duties as provided hereinafter.

2.3. It is hereby declared and agreed by and between the parties to these presents that the Trustees herein shall apply at the first instance the income/receipts or usufructs of the Trust Property and thereafter the Corpus thereof for discharging all of its statutory or legal liabilities and/or other obligations as may be required for proper administration of the said Trust and/or its assets and properties and for the purposes and objects of the said Trust.

2.4. The **AUTHOR/SETTLOR** and/or **FIRST PARTY** herein and his legal heirs, successors, executors, administrators, representatives, and assigns etc. shall also be the beneficiaries of the said Trust.

2.5. The said Trust, namely **"ZYCON FOUNDATION"** as hereby created and being a Public Non-Profitable, Non-Commercial and Charitable Trust, shall herein be called and referred to as the '**said Trust**'.

3. NAME

3.1. **Name** of the said Trust shall be **"ZYCON FOUNDATION"** with liberty to the Trustees to change the name of the Trust in future with the consent of the **AUTHOR/SETTLOR** or with the consent of Board of Trustees.

4. OFFICE

4.1. The **REGISTERED OFFICE** of the said Trust shall be at **125 Brij East, Shanti Sadan, 2nd Floor, Flat No. 3, Kolkata- 700084, Police Station - Patuli, West Bengal, India**, which will also be treated as the **HEAD OFFICE** of the said Trust. However, the said Trust may change the office at such other places as may be found suitable for its smooth functioning from time to time. There may be several **BRANCH OFFICES** of the said Trust in different places at a time as may be required and found suitable from time to time.

5. DECLARATION

5.1. In order to effectuate the said desire, the **AUTHOR/SETTLOR** herein, has made over and assigned to the Trustees herein a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) to hold the same and the investments thereof for the time being representing the same together with all further gifts and donations that may be received by the Trustees herein

and all additions and accretions thereto and all accumulated income thereof and all other properties that may be acquired out of the same and subject to the powers and provisions hereinafter contained solely for implementing the objects hereinafter stated.

6. OBJECTS

The objects of the said Trust shall be in the nature of charitable purposes and providing services at free of cost within the meaning under the Income Tax Act, 1961 which are broadly stated as hereunder:

6.1 To open, found, establish and maintain schools, colleges and Boarding houses, and Sanskrit Vidyalyays.

6.2 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Education, Elementary Education, School Education and Literacy, Higher Education, Research and Development, Training, Learning, Knowledge Building, Knowledge Development, Advancement of Knowledge, Publications, Personality Building, Adult Education, Public Awareness, Social Awareness, Skill-Development, Manpower Development, and Human Resource Development at free of cost.

6.3 To assist and/or establish, maintain and run Educational Institutions, Educational Centers, Schools, Social Service Centers, Colleges, Professional Colleges, Universities, Research Institutions, Technical/ Non-Technical Institutions, and other Institutions for quality education to all and advancement of knowledge at free of cost.

6.4 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Medical/ Health Sciences and Allied Sciences, Medical/ Health and Allied Education, Medical/ Health and Allied Research, Medical/ Health and Allied Services, Human Health and Wellbeing (Physical and/or Mental), Human Health Welfare and Family Welfare, Human Health Awareness at free of cost.

6.5 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of General Welfare, Public Welfare, General Public Utility, Social Welfare, Human Welfare, Human Development, Human Rights, Human Spiritual Development, Human Moral Character Development, Humanity Development, Human Social Life Development, Human and Family Wellness, and Advancement of overall Human Life, etc. at free of cost.

6.6 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Wildlife Welfare, Animal Welfare, and Veterinary Sciences at free of cost.

6.7 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Earth Sciences, New and Renewable Energy, Safe Drinking Water and Sanitation, River Development, Welfare and/or Conservations to the Environment, Water Resources, Forests and Climates at free of cost.

6.8 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Agriculture, Farming, and Welfare to the Farmers at free of cost.

6.9 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Science and Technology at free of cost.

6.10 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Arts, Literatures, Crafts and Cultures at free of cost.

6.11 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Law, Justice and Judicial Sciences at free of cost.

6.12 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Community Developments, Social Developments, Social Activities, Social Services, Social Work, Social Sciences, Social Issues, Social Entrepreneurship, Social Business, Social Finance, Ethical Banking, Social Securities, Social Justice and Empowerment at free of cost.

6.13 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Backward Classes Welfare and Tribal Affairs, Youth Affairs, Consumer Affairs, Rural Development, Development of the Urban Poor, Women and Child Development at free of cost.

6.14 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of needful as well as lawful activities for alleviating the poverty and providing relief and/or supports to the deprived, needy and/or economically backward public for the management of their basic needs and requirements to maintain a standard sustainable life at free of cost.

6.15 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of lawful activities to generate Works and Employments at free of cost.

6.16 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Managements towards Natural Disasters and Calamities, and Man-Made Disasters at free of cost.

6.17 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Food and Nutrition, Nourishment to the Mothers, Children, Aged Persons and Medical Patients, Nourishment to the Sports Persons and other Professionals, Food Science and Technology, Food Processing and Preservation, Culinary, and Food Safety at free of cost.

6.18 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Sports and Physical Exercise, Physical Performance and Endurance, Aerobics, Yoga and Meditation, Physical Fitness and Self-Defence Training, Sports Science and Education, and Allied Disciplines at free of cost.

6.19 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Tourism, Tours and Travels, Excursions, and Expeditions for the advancement of Education and Research, Knowledge and Learning, Health and Wellbeing (Physical and/or Mental) at free of cost.

6.20 To conduct tours and travel services for tourists from inside and outside of India to various historical places, famous tourist spots, ancient temples and UNESCO World Heritage spots in India to enrich them with India's rich culture and heritage at free of cost.

6.21 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Services with Public Interests (such as but not limited to Educational Services, Health Services, Research Services, Culinary Services, Transportation Services, Communication Services, Courier Services, Tour and Travel Services, Legal Services, Consultancy Services, Professional Services, and other Wellness, Wellbeing and/or Welfare Services) at free of cost.

6.22 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Social Events and/or Social programs for the advancement of Social Integrity and Social Harmony.

6.23 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of observance of the Events, Dates and/or Days, Months, and Years having International and/or National importance and/or Regional significance at free of cost.

6.24 To promote, support, and cultivate the totality in the area of Public Charitable Works and Activities at free of cost.

6.25 To establish, maintain and run schools, social service centre, industrial training centre, colleges, professional colleges, technical and non-technical institution of all kinds with hostel and/or boarding facility including research institutions for good education and advancement of knowledge to all with special emphasis to poor and unaffordable students at free of cost.

6.26 To provide personality development training, counseling and motivation training etc. at free of cost.

6.27 To establish and run special schools and institutions for physically and mentally challenged people in the community at free of cost.

6.28 To establish and run various vocational/skill development training courses/centers and give students certificate after completing their training and to help to develop their self employment skills at free of cost.

6.29 To run meditation and yoga training centers, computer training centers and study centers at free of cost.

6.30 To promote, establish, equip, erect, maintain, and/or grant financial assistance to schools, colleges, medical colleges, engineering and technical colleges, international school for higher studies, International Business School, University, Deemed University, Media Science, Film & TV activity, dispensaries, hospitals, laboratories, hostels, public rest houses, libraries and any other similar works for furtherance and dissemination of education in general, medical/engineering and/or any other streams.

6.31 To establish and maintain scholarships and/or granting aid to the poor students either as absolute gift or as loan upon terms and conditions as to repayment without or with interest as the Trustees in their absolute discretion may think fit and proper.

6.32 To grant aid to poor students and/or poor and indigent people for their maintenance and/or housing and/or education of children of poor and indigent people and also for granting aid to persons with objects of public utility.

6.33 To establish, maintain and grant aid to public charitable institutions for advancement of education in any streams, medical relief

and/or other objects of general public utility and/or for granting aid to poor and destitute persons.

6.34 To establish, maintain and/or grant aid to aged persons and persons who are physically disabled or unfit for earning their livelihood.

6.35 To promote, establish, support, maintain, and/or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science and/or literature and/or technical and/or medical science for diffusion of useful knowledge, health care and clinical establishment, social activities, self help group, agro-based research, floriculture, green energy etc., any kinds of publication of Journals, Literatures, News Letters etc.

6.36 To establish and run hospitals, health centre, maternity homes, child clinic and specialized medical care institutions without profit motive to meet with the medical needs of poor and underprivileged people.

6.37 To undertake and promote rural community health care and awareness programs in villages.

6.38 To undertake emergency relief works for the victims of flood, fire, famine, earthquake and other disaster with impede development.

6.39 To establish and run charitable hospitals, pre-primary and primary educational institutions, libraries, cultural centre and to publish/distribute magazines and books for the fulfillment of the above objects and to do other charitable services for orphanage, sick, helpless and indigent persons.

6.40 To promote all types of sports and cultural activities amongst public.

6.41 To start, establish, promote, maintain, run, manage, supervise, affiliate, control, guide and grant aid to hospitals, health centre, maternity

homes, child clinic and specialized medical care institutions and other Educational Institutions for the promotion of art, literature, science, commerce and industrialization.

6.42 To engage and/or appoint experts and officers, instructors, employ staff and other employees, servant and agents for the purposes of the said Trust and its projects and to pay their salaries, wages and remunerations.

6.43 To distribute cotton, woolen, silken, blankets, rugs, quilts, clothing, raw or cooked food, medicines etc. and also give such donation of financial assistance as such other articles as the Trustees may deem fit, to the poor and/or needy people of the society.

6.44 To hold, assist, sponsor and promote medical camp for blood donation, vaccination, health awareness programs, immunizations, health checkup and other camps meant for general public utility.

6.45 To establish or to contribute to the maintenance of Gymnasiums, Sporting Clubs and Physical activities.

6.46 To foster the spirit and spread ideals of understandings, unity and brotherhood among the people at large of different castes, creeds, religions and sex and to promote National integration amongst them.

6.47 To grant and pay awards, stipend, scholarship, and certificate in respect of or relating to or concerning health care, education, agriculture and any research work and to assist and give award and/or rewards to social workers, social activists, sportsmen, writers, journalists, defence personals, other eminent persons for appreciating their extra ordinary skills and achievements and/or contribution to the Nation, students etc. in deserving cases and to the one in need.

6.48 To work for the eradication and elimination of social evil and superstitions.

6.49 To make arrangements for lectures and seminars for advancement of health awareness and to do such service and activities in relation to spreading of social, political and economical education.

6.50 To develop and undertake herbal cultivation, spices and to importance of alternative herbal medicines and nutritional substitutes.

6.51 To assist the people in need to undertake improved animal husbandry, cottage and small scale industries and co-operative ventures to enhance their economic condition and to effect sustainable development.

6.52 To assist women and men to form self help groups.

6.53 To initiate and promote family welfare, adult literacy, general awareness education specifically on health and hygiene, environmental sanitation, reproductive and child health etc.

6.54 To do lawful activities for charitable purposes.

6.55 To provide lawful services for charitable purposes.

6.56 To do all such things incidental to the aforesaid objects of the said Trust.

7 DONORS AND DONATIONS

7.3 The Trustees herein may accept from time to time from any persons, either national or NRI's by maintaining all legal norms and valid documents, firm or any other associations of persons, trusts or institutions or societies and/or bodies corporate or incorporate, governments, local authorities, universities or any other body, any entity or entities, both domestic and foreign, donations, subscriptions, money, things, properties, moveable gifts, sponsorship money as per the guide line of RBI and also by following the rules and laws of foreign exchange, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between them and the donor or donors

and as may be considered advisable and expedient by the Trustees herein but always consistent with the objects of the said Trust and limited to the said Trust of these presents.

7.4 The Trustees herein shall hold the same upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon and utilize the corpus or income/receipts thereof, in such manner and proportions in the fulfillment of the object or objects of the said Trust and if necessary, to execute such writings or instruments in respect thereof as they may from time to time approve of and direct in respect of the said donations, subscriptions, etc. and for the purpose of collections of such donations, formulate a scheme or schemes including installations of boxes and devise and adopt such other means as they may think fit and proper in this regard from time to time.


7.5 It shall be the discretion of the Trustees herein to refuse any donations, contribution and/or offer of help, assistance or gift from any person/ organization without assigning any reason.

7.6 The Trustees herein, if they think fit and proper and for the benefit of the said Trust, may accept loans, secured or unsecured, from banks and/or financial institutions or from any other private sources for specific purposes authorized by these presents and the amount so raised shall be utilized only for such purposes, which shall always be commensurate with the objects of the said Trust.

8 POWER OF THE TRUSTEES

The **TRUSTEES** herein will have the following powers:

8.3 The Trustees herein may apply for, accept, and/or receive any grants, aids, donations, contributions in cash or in kind, subscriptions, moneys, things, properties, moveable gifts, assistance, gifts, sponsorship



money, etc from time to time from any persons, NRIs, foreign nationals, firm or any other associations of persons, trusts or institutions or societies and/or corporate bodies, corporation, companies, governments, public bodies, urban or local body, local authorities, lawful organizations, universities or any other body, any entity or entities, both domestic and foreign, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the Trustees herein and the donors and as may be considered advisable and expedient by the Trustees herein but always consistent with the objects of the said Trust. In addition, the Trustees herein shall at all times be at liberty to refuse any grants, aids, donations, contributions in cash or in kind, subscriptions, moneys, things, properties, moveable gifts, assistance, gifts, sponsorship money, etc, without being bound to give any reason for such refusal.

8.4 The Trustees herein may follow the instructions given by donor who makes substantial contributions towards furtherance of the objects of the said Trust, so long as such instructions are not detrimental to the attainment of the objects of the said Trust and are in conformity with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961.

8.5 The Trustees herein, if they think fit and proper and for the benefit of the said Trust, may borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys (with or without security) and/or accept loans (secured or unsecured) from banks and/or financial institutions and/or government or from any other private sources (such as any person or entity or foreign nationals, NRIs, institutions or agencies or individuals) and the amount so raised shall be utilized only for such purposes which shall always be commensurate with the objects of the said Trust. In addition, the Trustees herein shall at all times be at liberty to make such terms and conditions on borrowings as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and proper.

8.6 The Trustees herein may collect subscriptions, fees, payments, money, and otherwise from the public for rendering services to them and for furtherance of the said Trust's objects and for benefit of the said Trust.

8.7 The Trustees herein may generate income/ revenue/ funds through any lawful business in the name of the said Trust, any other institutions/ organizations run and/or conducted by the said Trust, and/or through any other lawful means for the benefit of the said Trust and/or for fulfilling the objects of the said Trust.

8.8 The Trustees herein can receive, collect and enforce recovery of all monies due or payable to the said Trust and grant receipts and discharges therefore.

8.9 The Trustees herein may give a receipt in writing for any money, securities or other moveable property payable, transferable or deliverable to the said Trust.

8.10 The Trustees herein may give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust funds or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or trusts which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for charitable objects whether wholly or in part similar with the said Trust, by maintain legal norms and valid documents.

8.11 The Trustees herein may accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person(s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions or from foreigner present in India, any government or private institutions or agencies or individuals according to the prevailing law of the land.

8.12 The Trustees herein may apply the whole or any part of the income of the said Trust or the Trust fund or accumulation thereto, to any

one or more of the objects of the Trust as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.

8.13 The Trustees herein may engage and/or appoint experts and officers, instructors, employ staff and other employees, servant and agents for the purposes of the said Trust and its objects and to pay their salaries, wages and remunerations.

8.14 The Trustees herein may borrow or raise or secure payments of money, with or without security, from banks, financial institutions, or any other person or entity, or from any private or government institutions or agencies or individuals according either within India or abroad to the prevailing law of the land and also to lend money either with or without security.

8.15 The Trustees herein may sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust fund, subject to the permission of the Court and/or Competent Authority.

8.16 The Trustees herein may let out, demise any immoveable property comprise in the funds of the said Trust for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees herein in their discretion may think fit and proper.

8.17 The Trustees herein may open account in the name of the said Trust with any nationalized or private or co-operative bank or banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to the banks and to provide for opening and operations of such account/s by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent or by an authorized signatory appointed by the Trustees.

8.18 The Trustees herein may adjust, settle, compromise, compound, and refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust fund and Trust matters.

8.19 The Trustees herein may appoint constituted attorneys or agents and may delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the power vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorneys or agents and may appoint other or others in his or their place.

8.20 The Trustees herein may appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or managing Trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the said Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe.

8.21 The Trustees herein may make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the said Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the said Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the said Trust.

8.22 The Trustees herein may start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.

8.23 The Trustees herein may start any institutions and/or organizations for the furtherance of the said Trust's objects and to abolish, discontinue, and/or restart such institutions and/or organizations, if needed.

8.24 The Trustees herein may set apart and/or allocate the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the said Trust.

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8.25 The Trustees herein may join, co-operate, affiliate, amalgamate, take over or merge with any other lawful organizations having objects whether wholly or in part similar to those of the said Trust.

8.26 The Trustees herein may sell (subject to the permission of the Court), buy, invest, improve, manage, grant, lease, hire, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with all or any part of the properties/funds of the said Trust in a lawful manner, from time to time, for any of the lawful purposes thereof.

8.27 The Trustees herein may give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or trust in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institutions, societies, organizations or trusts to start maintain or carryout such charitable objects.

8.28 The Trustees herein may settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or dispute, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.

8.29 The Trustees herein may borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.

8.30 The Trustees herein may apply to the government, public bodies, urban or local body, Municipal and Panchayat Bodies, District and other bodies, corporation, companies or persons for grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance and accept the same

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with a view to promoting the objects of the said Trust and may discuss and negotiate with the government departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies, or persons on scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the said Trust and may confirm to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.

8.31 The Trustees herein may establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain any branch of the said Trust or to assist any other organizations in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing or maintaining their branches with objects whether wholly or in part similar with the said Trust and may promote to carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other organizations with the said Trust.

8.32 The Trustees herein may takeover, manage, control or acquire or aid any existing institution or institutions or organizations having objects whether wholly or in part similar to the objects of the said Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.

8.33 The Trustees herein may purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the properties, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which the said Trust is authorized to amalgamate.

8.34 The Trustees herein may transfer all or any part of the properties, assets, liabilities and engagements of the said Trust to any one or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which the said Trust is authorized to amalgamate.

8.35 The Trustees herein may maintain to set of advisors or an organization with remuneration for the purpose of utilizing their services in furtherance of the objects of the said Trust.

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8.36 The Trustees herein may engage and/or appoint experts and officers, instructors, employ staff and other employees, servant and agents for the purposes of the said Trust and its projects and to pay their salaries, wages and remunerations.

8.37 The Trustees herein may do all acts which are reasonable and proper for the realization, protection or benefit of the Trust-property, and for the protection or support of any object of the said Trust.

8.38 The Trustees herein may announce, from time to time, projects, programmers, and schemes in accordance with the objects of the said Trust and for such purpose may invite written applications on prescribed forms from the intending applicants, but it shall be at the sole discretion of the Trustees herein to grant or reject any application without giving any reason thereof.

8.39 The Trustees herein may from time to time frame resolutions and rules or amend, modify, add to, and delete such rules for conducting the affairs of the said Trust and for regulating the meetings of the Trustees herein.

8.40 The Trustees herein may exercise all powers ancillary and incidental to effectively carry out the objects of the said Trust.

9 ADMINISTRATION & BOARD OF TRUSTEES

9.3 The FOUNDER TRUSTEES herein shall automatically form the Board of Trustees to administer the said Trust as well as to manage the funds/properties of the said Trust. **SRI PUKAL MISTRY**, the FIRST PARTY and/or FOUNDER TRUSTEE and/or MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, shall be the **CHAIRMAN** of the Board of Trustees herein for his LIFETIME. The MANAGING TRUSTEE and/or FOUNDER TRUSTEES herein shall always be at liberty to attend their offices at per their convenience.

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9.4 Co-Trustees other than the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein cannot act singly. All Trustees must join to form the Board of Trustees in the execution of the said Trust. The decision taken by the Board of Trustees shall be final and shall be abided by all Trustees. However, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall hold the discretionary power to administer the said Trust and to deal with the said Trust's matters as he deems fit and proper. The Board of Trustees herein shall always be under the supervision and/or guidance of the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein who may take decisions as per his own discretion to administer and manage the said Trust; whereas, the other Trustees herein shall help and co-operate with the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein to run the administration and management of the said Trust. In addition, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall has the power to assign duties amongst the other Trustees herein and assign their respective roles, responsibilities, powers, and official designations, with a specified tenure, in the Board of Trustees herein for the smooth running and functioning of the said Trust as per his own discretion. The FIRST PARTY/ MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall exercise all powers ancillary and incidental to effectively carry out the administration and/or objects of the said Trust.

9.5 The rules/ regulations/ resolutions/ policies/ guidelines to administer and manage the said Trust shall be framed and/or altered by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein in consultation with other Trustees herein. In case of any difference of opinion between the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein and the other Trustees herein regarding the said Trust's matters, whatsoever in nature, the opinion of the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall prevail and the decisions and/or resolutions taken by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall be final and that shall be abided by all the Trustees herein. In case if any difference of opinion between the Trustees herein regarding the said Trust's matters, whatsoever in nature,

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arises then under such circumstances the opinion of the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall prevail and cannot be disputed, rejected and/or stopped by any of the other Trustees herein and such decisions of the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall be final. The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall be entitled to take final decision for and on behalf of the said Trust and that shall be abided by all the Trustees herein.

9.6 In addition to discharging normal duties of a Trustee, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall preside over meeting of the Board of Trustees herein. The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein is authorized to sign all documents, including bank documents, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, Government Institutions and other organizations, on behalf of the Board of Trustees herein. The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall have all the residuary powers, not explicitly assigned to any of the other Trustees in these presents.

9.7 The total number of Trustees in the Board of Trustees herein, including the FOUNDER TRUSTEES, shall not be less than THREE and more than NINE.

9.8 The Board of Trustees herein shall hold the powers to administer the said Trust, its properties and affairs and do all the things which will fulfill the performance of the objects for which the said Trust is established and for this purpose the Board of Trustees herein can apply the whole or any part of the Trust property towards the payment of the expenses of the said Trust.

9.9 Any Trustee herein shall be at liberty to resign from his office by giving one month's prior notice to the CHAIRMAN of the Board of Trustees herein expressing his intention to do so. However, the AUTHOR/SETTLOR and/or MANAGING TRUSTEE herein may have the absolute power and

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authority to remove any Trustee herein from his office if that Trustee is found to be inconsistent/ incompatible/ unpleasant with the activities of the said Trust and/or found to be guilty in accordance with law.

9.10 With the consent from the FIRST PARTY and/or AUTHOR/SETTLOR and/or MANAGING TRUSTEE herein a Trustee herein may delegate his Trusteeship/ office/ duty to any other person if such delegation is necessary for the said Trust's matters; however, the FIRST PARTY and/or AUTHOR/SETTLOR and/or MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall be at liberty to take final decision on such delegation at per his own discretion.

9.11 The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall be the sole authority to operate and manage the bank accounts, to sign, execute, and prepare papers, documents and deeds on behalf of the said Trust. However, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein may delegate his such powers to any other Trustee(s) as he may deem fit and proper, who will manage the same on behalf of the said Trust.

10 CHAIRING AND SUCCESSION

10.3 **SRI PUKAL MISTRY**, the FIRST PARTY as well as the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, shall be the CHAIRMAN of the Board of Trustees herein and shall hold the position of the CHAIRMAN of the said Trust for his LIFETIME and if he dies and/or decides to resign and/or refuses to act and/or otherwise incapable to work as the CHAIRMAN of the said Trust then the CHAIRMANSHIP, MANAGING TRUSTEESHIP, LIFETIME TRUSTEESHIP, LEADERSHIP, and all the powers/ functions/ rights herein held by him shall pass to LIPIKA GAYEN, the SECOND PARTY as well as the FOUNDER TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise shall pass to the **SPOUSE** of **SRI PULAK MISTRY**, the FIRST PARTY herein, or otherwise shall pass to the assignee of **SRI PULAK MISTRY**, the FIRST PARTY herein.

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11 APPOINTMENT AND DISCHARGE OF NEW TRUSTEES

11.3 To fill up any vacancy in the Board of Trustees herein, whether caused by resignation, incapability, death, and/or otherwise, a new Trustee may be appointed by the person, nominated for that purpose by the AUTHOR/SETTLOR of the said Trust, if any, or by the AUTHOR/SETTLOR of the said Trust himself. Thereafter, such appointments may be made by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein in consultation with other continuing or surviving Trustees of the said Trust. In case of any difference of opinion between the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein and the other continuing or surviving Trustees of the said Trust regarding the appointment of new Trustees, the opinion of the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall prevail and that shall be abided by all the Trustees herein. Every such appointment shall be by writing under the hand of the person making it, i.e. under the hand of the appointing authority. On an appointment of a new Trustee the number of Trustees in the Board of Trustees herein may be increased.

11.4 The newly appointed Trustee herein shall be responsible to perform all the duties and functions on behalf of the said Trust as entrusted to him by the appointing authority and he shall automatically be discharged from his office either by the completion of his duties under the said Trust or by the completion of two years from the date of his appointment, whichever is earlier, or by such means as may be prescribed in the appointment letter issued by the appointing authority. However, the newly appointed Trustee herein after performing the duties and functions satisfactorily may be re-appointed by the appointing authority.

11.5 The newly appointed Trustee herein at any stage of their Trusteeship may be considered as the permanent and/or lifetime Trustee of the said Trust with sole discretion of the appointing authority. In



addition, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall hold the powers to suspend, dismiss, or otherwise deal with such newly appointed/ re-appointed/ permanent/ lifetime Trustees of the said Trust.

11.6 Provided that appointment of the Trustee as aforesaid shall be subject to the condition that the new Trustee(s) shall provide interest free Deposit of not less than Rs 1 (one) lakh to the foundation which shall be refunded on his/her ceasing to be Trustee of the foundation. The purpose of providing interest free Deposit as aforesaid is only to augment the fund of the trust in order to carry out its activities smoothly and to ensure the commitment and involvement of the incoming person towards the activities of the trust.

12 MEETING(S) OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND QUORUM

12.3 Meetings of the Board of Trustees herein shall take place, from time to time, for taking any decision/ resolution on behalf of the said Trust and for observing the activities and functioning of the said Trust and the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise the CHAIRMAN, shall hold the power to summon such meetings as and when he may deem fit and that all the Trustees herein shall be under the compulsion to attend such meetings for the benefit and smooth functioning of the said Trust. Meetings of the Board of Trustees herein shall be held via telephonic-conference, video-conference, and/or any other suitable modes and at such places and on such time as may be decided by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise by the CHAIRMAN of the said Trust. The meeting agenda and rules/ regulations to convene such meetings shall be framed by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise by the CHAIRMAN of the said Trust. Notice for such meetings and all communications may be sent to the Trustees herein at their respective e-mail/home addresses as registered in the records of the said Trust.



12.4 The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall preside over all the meetings of the said Trust and also act as the CHAIRMAN of all meetings of the said Trust as per his own discretion. A majority of the Trustees herein must be present to form a Quorum to constitute a valid meeting of the Board of Trustees herein or to transact any of its business; however, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall be entitled to take final decisions and/or resolutions for and on behalf of the said Trust and that shall be abided by all the Trustees herein. Minutes of each meeting shall be prepared by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise by the CHAIRMAN, and shall be signed by all of the Trustees herein who will be present at the said meeting and the same will be circulated amongst all of the other Trustees herein.

12.5 The Board of Trustees herein shall meet at least twice in every calendar year in addition to the Annual General Meeting and Emergent Meeting(s). The Board of Trustees herein may meet more often whenever required. The meeting of the Board of Trustees herein shall be convened by the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein and he shall preside over the meetings. In his absence, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein may authorize any other Trustee herein to be the Chairman of such meetings.

12.6 Except the Annual General Meeting and Emergent Meeting(s), the Managing Trustee shall convene meeting of the Trustees or Board of Trustees by giving at least 7 day's notice to all the other Trustees herein.

12.7 Communications between the Trustees herein may be made over telephone, e-mail, video-conference, and/or fax in addition to letters. However, all such communications shall be duly filed in physical form with the records of the said Trust.

13 ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

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13.3 The Trustees herein shall keep proper books of account of all the assets, liabilities and income and expenditure of the said Trust and shall prepare an income and expenditure account and Balance Sheet for every year.

13.4 The accounts of every year shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountants who shall be appointed for that purpose by the Trustees herein and the audited accounts shall be placed at a meeting of the Trustees herein, which shall be held before the end of the succeeding year.

13.5 Proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursement on account of the said Trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the Trustees herein and shall be duly audited with all necessary vouchers every year by auditors as mentioned above. The Trustees herein shall also fix the remuneration of such auditors.

13.6 The accounting year of the said Trust shall be the financial year commencing on 1st April and ending on 31st March of the subsequent year, provided however, that the Trustees herein shall be at liberty to change the same from time to time, if they deem fit and proper.

14 APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX

Notwithstanding any contained herein in the income as the corpus of the said Trust:

14.3 The Trust fund shall be applicable and applied for Public Charitable Purpose only within such territories and subject to such conditions or limitation, if any as may from time to time be laid down by the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any other acts governing taxation of income the wealth of Public Charitable Trust as so to render under Act or acts, now or prevailing or any modification replacement thereof.

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14.4 To act in such a way that the said Trust hereby established shall always retain the status of one such Trust to which provisions of Section 80G/12A/FCRA/35AC/10 (23C) IV/V/VIA, if the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any modification replacement or thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation or contribution thereof is recognized as eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hands of the donor as well as the said Trust.

15 BANK ACCOUNTS

15.3 The Trustees herein shall hold the power to open bank accounts in the name of the said Trust, any other institutions/ organizations run and/or conducted by the said Trust with any nationalized/ private/ co-operative banks etc. as the Trustees herein may deem fit and proper as per their convenience. The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall have the sole authority to operate such bank accounts and to sign and/or execute any papers to that effect and to give instructions to the bank and to provide instructions for opening and operations of such accounts by one or more of the Trustees herein or by an agent or by an authorized signatory appointed by the Board of Trustees herein. However, the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein may delegate his such powers to any other Trustee(s) as he may deem fit and proper; who will operate and manage the said bank accounts and execute such bank related documents on his behalf and also on behalf of the said Trust.

15.4 All income of subscriptions and pecuniary donations for the general purposes of the said Trust and the income from investments and all other money received from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the said Trust shall be paid into one or more bank accounts.

16 FUNDS AND PROPERTIES

16.3 The funds and properties of the said Trust mean the said sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) which is contributed by the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein, and all other properties at any time added thereto by way of purchase, further settlements, gifts, donations, acquisitions, accumulations of income and capital accretions or otherwise and all properties movable or immovable from time to time belonging to or owned by the said Trust.


16.4 The funds and properties of the said Trust shall be utilized for the objects of the said Trust as mentioned herein above and subject to the provisions and conditions herein mentioned. The Board of Trustees herein may apply the whole or any part of the income of the said Trust, or the funds/ properties of the said Trust or accumulation thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the said Trust, as the Board of Trustees herein may, in its discretion, deem fit and proper from time to time. The Board of Trustees herein may purchase or acquire any property by utilizing the funds of the said Trust for the purpose of meeting the objects of the said Trust.

17 ADVISORS

The First Trustee Board shall consist of following persons:

1. SRI PULAK MISTRY President and Trustee
2. SMT. LIPIKA GAYEN Vice President and Trustee
3. SMT. LIPIKA GAYEN Treasurer and Trustee

17.2 The Trustees herein may maintain advisors for furtherance of the management of the said Trust and for performing the administration of any particular object of the said Trust by engaging their services in accordance with a legal contract/ agreement. In addition, the Board of Trustees herein shall be at liberty to fix remuneration, out of the funds of the said Trust,



for such advisors. The Board of Trustees herein shall also hold the powers to suspend, dismiss or otherwise deal with such advisors.

17.3 The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall hold the absolute power and authority to terminate the engagement of any advisor of the said Trust if that advisor is found to be inconsistent/ incompatible/ unpleasant with the activities of the said Trust and/or found to be guilty in accordance with law. In case of terminating such engagement of any advisor the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein may call meeting and notice the other Trustees herein to that effect.

17.1 If any Trustee herein acts as an advisor of the said Trust or renders any special service to the said Trust then the Board of Trustees herein may in its discretion pay remuneration or allowances, out of the funds of the said Trust, to such Trustee as an advisor of the said Trust and/or as a service provider to the said Trust, as the Board of Trustees herein may think fit and proper.

18 RULES AND REGULATIONS OF TRUST

MEMBERS

Members may join the Foundation from all over the India. Any person who is citizen of India can become Ordinary institutional member of the Trust by paying annual subscription of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred one only).

19 MEMBERSHIP FEES:-

a) To become a member of the Trust Rs. 500/- will be the membership fees.

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b) Continue the membership of the Trust by paying annual subscription of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred one only).

c) To become the life time member of the Trust Rs.5000/-(Rupees Five Thousand only) will be the Lifetime membership fees.

Trustee and life time members shall jointly constitute General Body which will be responsible for administration and functioning of the Trust and shall have last word in all matters of the Trust.

Any Ordinary Member not paying annual subscription at least two months before the annual general meeting shall be de recognized and shall not have any right of such membership.

20. OFFICE BEARERS, STAFFS, AND WORKERS

20.1 The Trustees herein shall hold the powers to appoint any person/ individual and/or lawful entity as office bearers, staffs, workers, etc. for the purpose of administration, functioning, maintenance, business, lawful activities, objects of the said Trust and to frame provisions for such appointment in such a manner and subject to such rules and regulations and subject to such legal contract/ agreement as the Trustees herein may, from time to time, think fit and proper. In addition, the Board of Trustees herein shall also hold the powers to frame rules relating to pay salaries/ remunerations and other benefits, out of the funds of the said Trust, for such appointees. The Board of Trustees herein shall also hold the powers to suspend, dismiss or otherwise deal with such appointees.

20.2 The MANAGING TRUSTEE herein shall hold the absolute power and authority to terminate the appointment of any appointee of the said Trust if that appointee is found to be inconsistent/ incompatible/ unpleasant with the activities of the said Trust and/or found to be guilty in accordance with law. In case of terminating such appointment of any

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appointee the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein may call meeting and notice the other Trustees herein to that effect.

20.3 If any Trustee herein acts as an office-bearer, staff, or worker of the said Trust or renders any special service to the said Trust then the Board of Trustees herein may in its discretion pay remuneration or allowances and other benefits, out of the funds of the said Trust, to such Trustee as an office-bearer, staff, or worker of the said Trust and/or as a service provider to the said Trust, as the Board of Trustees herein may think fit and proper.


21 COLLABORATIONS

a. The said Trust may collaborate with other non-profitable organizations, charitable organizations, profit-making organizations, non-governmental organizations, governmental organizations, and other relevant lawful organizations worldwide to carry out the objects of the said Trust on such terms and conditions as the Trustees herein may think fit and proper in their absolute discretion.

22 AMENDMENT OF THE TRUST DEED

22.1 The AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein may amend, change, alter, modify, add or delete the provisions of the Trust Deed of the said Trust, as he deems fit and proper, as per law. Thereafter the Board of Trustees herein, if found necessary or desirable, may take resolution and/or decision with the consent of the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein, or otherwise the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise the majority of the Trustees herein, to amend change, alter, modify, add or delete the provisions of the Trust Deed of the said Trust, as it deem fit and proper, as per law.

22.2 The amendments, changes, alterations, modifications, additions or deletions made in the Trust Deed of the said Trust will not affect any act already done by the Trustees herein in execution of the said Trust.



22.3 No amendment, change, alteration, modification, addition or deletion shall be made in the Trust Deed of the said Trust which will cause the said Trust to cease to be charitable in nature as per law.

23 AMALGAMATION

23.1 The said Trust may amalgamate with any other charitable organizations having objects whether wholly or in part similar with the said Trust on such terms and conditions as the Board of Trustees herein may think fit and proper in its absolute discretion.

23.2 The Board of Trustees herein may purchase or otherwise acquire and/or undertake all or any part of the properties, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the other lawful organizations, trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which the said Trust is authorized to amalgamate.

23.3 The Board of Trustees herein may transfer all or any part of the properties, assets, liabilities and engagements of the said Trust to any one or more of the other lawful organizations, trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which the said Trust is authorized to amalgamate. The properties will vest on the said similar trust or other lawful organization.

24 DISSOLUTION

24.1 The said Trust is irrevocable in nature. However, only the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein shall reserves the right to make the sole decision to dissolve the said Trust in accordance with law. Thereafter the Board of Trustees herein, if found necessary or desirable, may take resolution and/or decision with the consent of the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein, or otherwise the MANAGING TRUSTEE herein, or otherwise the majority of the Trustees herein, to dissolve the said Trust as per law or to



approach before the proper Civil Court as per law for obtaining necessary order regarding dissolution of the said Trust.

24.2 Upon such decision the said Trust shall take all necessary steps for the disposal and settlement of the fund, property, claims and liabilities of the said Trust as the Board of Trustees herein shall find expedient; and

24.3 On dissolution of the said Trust, if there any fund/ asset/ property whatsoever of the said Trust shall remain after satisfying the said Trust's debts and liabilities then the same will be given to any other charitable organizations having objects whether wholly or in part similar with the said Trust on such terms and conditions as the Board of Trustees herein may think fit and proper in its absolute discretion or to be disposed off in accordance with law.

25 APPLICABILITY OF THE INDIAN TRUSTS ACT, 1882

25.1 The provisions of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 shall apply to all matters not specially mentioned in these presents.

26 LAWFUL PURPOSE

26.1 A Trust may be created for any lawful purpose. The purpose of a Trust is lawful unless it is;

- a) forbidden by law or,
- b) is of such a nature that, if permitted, it would defeat the provisions of any law, or
- c) is fraudulent, or
- d) involves or implies, injury to the person or property of another, or
- e) The Court regards it as immoral or opposed to public policy.

Pulam Mistry

26.2 Every Trust of which the purpose is unlawful is void. And where a Trust is created for two purposes, of which one is lawful and the other unlawful and the two purposes cannot be separated, the whole Trust is void.

27 GENERAL PROVISIONS

27.1 The said Trust created by these presents shall be irrevocable for all times.

27.2 At present the said Trust has no immovable and landed property except the Trust Fund of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) and no landed property is settled in this Deed of Trust.

27.3 The said Trust will not act something which is illegal and unlawful in nature and contrary to the law of the country.

27.4 The said Trust formed hereby will be a Public Charitable Trust and will work for charitable purposes for the general public at large and no beneficiary shall has any right to the rents and profits of the Trust-property.

27.5 The said Trust formed hereby will be a Public Charitable Trust and will work for charitable purposes for the general public at large and the Trustees herein shall hold the sole right that the Trust-property shall be properly protected and held and administered by such proper persons and by a proper number of such persons as the Trustees herein may think fit and proper at their own discretion and no beneficiary shall has any such right.

27.6 The Trustees herein shall not commit any breach of trust of the funds/ properties of the said Trust or cause any loss to the said Trust's properties or commit fraud in the administration of the funds/ properties of the said Trust.

27.7 The Trustees herein will not be responsible for any act or default of his co-Trustees or the agents, employees or constituted attorneys appointed by them and for any loss unless such loss is occasioned by their own willful acts or defaults and/or done under their instructions.

27.8 No Trustee shall be liable for the acts or defaults of his predecessor(s).

27.9 The Trustees herein shall be entitled to use the corpus of the said Trust and/or income thereof for carrying out objects of the said Trust. No part of the Trust fund, either the corpus or the income there from, shall be utilized for any object other than that of the said Trust hereby created.

27.10 The Trustees herein shall hold honorary office and shall not be entitled to have remuneration as Trustees; however, they shall avail honorarium, out of the Trust-property/fund, at per such amount as the Board of Trustees herein may think fit and proper in its discretion from time to time.

27.11 The Trustees herein may reimburse themselves, or pay or discharge out of the Trust-property, all expenses actually incurred by them in or about the execution of the said Trust, or the realization, preservation or benefit of the Trust-property, or the protection or support or promotion of the objects of the said Trust.

27.12 Any dispute between the Trustees herein regarding the administration and functioning of the said Trust shall be settled amicably between them and the same shall be referred to arbitration.

Pulam Mishra

27.13 If the income/receipts from the Trust property in a particular year is not fully utilized, the unutilized income/receipts subject to the applicable provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any other or subsequent relevant statute, shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for the advancement of any of the objects of the said Trust.

27.14 If any article, clause or paragraph or part thereto of this Deed of Trust is held to be invalid, ruled illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, or unenforceable under present or future laws effective during the term of this Deed of Trust, then it is the intention of the AUTHOR/SETTLOR herein that the remainder of the Deed of Trust shall not be affected thereby.

27.15 Relevant clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the income/receipts of contributions and donations to the said Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the relevant Sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the Sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into force.

27.16 Nothing contained in the Deed shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees herein to indulge into any activity or spend the funds of the said Trust in any manner which is not prohibited by these presents or not prohibited by the Income Tax Act, 1961 and/or any other law in India in any manner whatsoever.

27.17 The Provisions of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 and Income Tax Act, 1961 shall apply where no provision has been made in these presents.








OPERATIONAL AREA

The governing body sits together once in two months to make the policy and the strategies including financial and statutory works to implement its welfare activities successfully.

Since the inception it emphasized on building local leadership, rural youth clubs and identification of local resources. The rural youth clubs are working wholeheartedly for improving the living standard of the poorer sections.

The goal is to create a revolving fund by formation of a large number of self-help groups and collection of regular savings for self-reliance, self-sufficiency and empowerment of the rural poor people.

significant impact on our economy as well as the mental health and wellness of those who are unemployed. This needs to be cured. Our organization, in this year, has

organized placement camp programme in association with managers of different reputed companies who conducted interview and selected eligible candidates for their company.

➤ EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME

modernization of our country. It shapes our future. But due to lack of financial and other problems, many poor children as well as youths lack

proper education. Our organization has helped many people by providing them educational programmes, skill training, coaching classes etc.

Medical Check-up Camps, Emergency Ambulance Services, Health Awareness Camps etc. during the year 2020-21 at several places in

Kolkata and nearby rural areas which has helped thousands of people in need.

➤ NURSING TRAINING INSTITUTE

Our organization has established a nursing training institute where we provide Nursing Training to thousands of people (especially women) at reasonable cost (or at no cost



depending upon the financial situation of the candidate) every year. We also provided a certificate of completion to them after they have successfully completed

support in order to make their future bright. Our organization has also arranged several educational programmes for them where they can learn new things and grow. We also protect women and child from any kind of bad situation like domestic violence, malnutrition etc.

➤ NATURAL CALAMITIES AND DISASTERS RELIEF PROGRAMME

Natural calamities are unexpected as well as if affects our life very badly. In India, there happens flood, cyclone, earthquake etc. quite frequently. Same happens in West

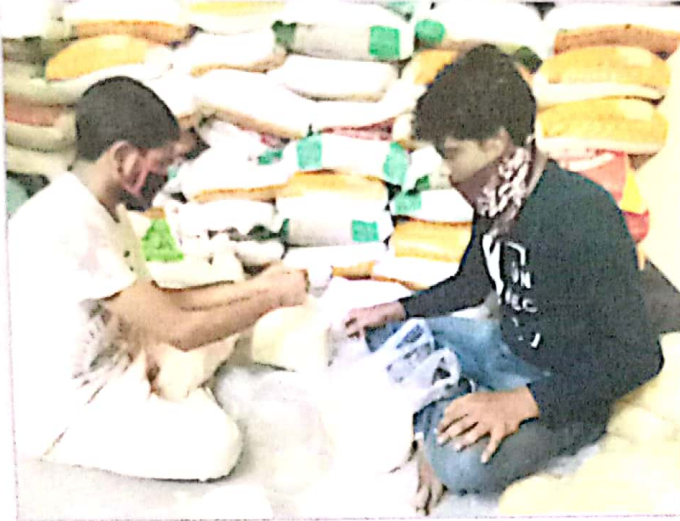


Bengal. Several people lost their life, shelter due to these. This year Cyclone Amphan, a very severe super

The Small Scale Industries plays a big role in the development and growth of our Country. It contributes a lot to our economy and its growth. Therefore the Small Scale Industries requires the help and support they deserve. Our organization, this year, arranged many seminars to provide tips and skills on how to grow in the current market. Many people joined the programme and benefitted.

➤ PROVIDE SERVICES TO DEVELOP THE FINANCIAL GROWTH OF POOR COMMUNITIES

Our organization this year helped many poor people who suffer from lack of financial support by providing them financial aid in need, motivational seminars for them to become self-reliant etc.

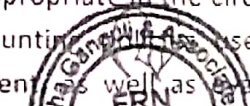
Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements
