## **INTRODUCTION**

ZYCON FOUNDATION was founded by some educated and dedicated youth and social workers with a view to work for the welfare and development of the society. Currently it helps the people especially in the backward areas and villages in the fields of Skill Development, Women Empowerment, Medical and Emergency Service to people etc. It is registered under Indian Trusts Act, 1882.

## **VISION AND MISSION STATEMENT**

ZYCON FOUNDATION envisages a society free that is from all sorts of discrimination. There will not be difference on nationality, religion, sex, colour, rich and poor. Human equality as mutual dignity, love respect, sincerity, correctness and self-confidence will be maintained and local destroyed culture should be revived. We will always work for the welfare and betterment of the society.

Our Mission is to provide help to the people especially the poor and downtrodden people, the unemployed and depressed youth, women, children etc.

Main Objects of ZYCON FOUNDATION are:

(1) Skills Development, (2) Provide work for the workless Community, (3) Education, (4) Medical Services, (5) Nursing training Institute, (6) Women & Child Protection, (7) Ambulance service, (8) Natural Disaster, (9) Natural Calamities, (10) Fight against Poverty, (11) Increases the small scale Industries, (12) Medical campaign, (13) Provide Services to develop the financial growth of poor communities, (14) Housing, (15) Advance Awareness.

## **OPERATIONAL AREA**

The organisation is at present working at backward areas in the district of Kolkata in West Bengal. The area is definitely a backward region in the state, where majority of the population are living Below Poverty Line and/or needs help and support.

## **TARGET GROUPS**

Underprivileged, economically backward section of the society with the priority to the destitute women and distressed children, older persons, disabled persons and students are the target groups of ZYCON FOUNDATION. During the year 2020-21, the organisation has covered 2000+ poor people through its multifarious development activities.



## **ORGANOGRAM OF THE ORGANISATION**

ZF, is governed, managed and controlled by an executive committee consisting of three members including one women member. It is managed by a team of experts comprising professionals from different sections of the society engaged in planning, coordination and implementation of various programs and communicate with various agencies related to the respective programs. The members of the executive committee are elected by the general members in the annual general meeting every year. The governing body then selects its office bearer's i.e. key signatories. The secretary has the role and function in all the affairs viz. daily routine work, administration, policy, finance, and strategies and in statutory works. The governing body sits together once in two months to make the policy and the strategies including financial and statutory works to implement its welfare activities successfully.

Since the organisation is focused in the backward area. It paid a serious attention rural development work. Since the inception it emphasized on building local leadership, rural youth clubs and identification of local resources. The rural youth clubs are working wholeheartedly for improving the living standard of the poorer sections.

## **POLICY INITIATIVE**

The organisation has given top priority on sustainable development through people's participation for creation of a permanent institution which will keep its eyes on all round development of the rural poor people. The goal is to create a revolving fund by formation of a large number of self-help groups and collection of regular savings for self-reliance, self-sufficiency and empowerment of the rural poor people.

## **MAN POWER**

The organisation has already got sufficient qualified, trained and experienced man power who are quite capable of implementing different social welfare and community development programs.

## A BRIEF RESUME OF ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANISATION DURING 2020-21

**ZYCON FOUNDATION** has implemented different types of socio-economic welfare activities during the year 2020-21 which has been mentioned hereunder in brief:

### ➤ Social Activities

#### ➤ COVID-19 AWARENESS AND DRY RATION DISTRIBUTION PROGRAMME



The major outbreak of COVID-19 (Coronavirus Infected Disease-2019) pandemic has affected many poor lives in India. Their source of income has been closed and their earning has stopped. It is causing significant financial crisis for them and they as

well as their dependents are suffering this. They need a helping hand to overcome the problems caused by the pandemic. Our organisation has distributed free dry ration and hand wash to almost 70 poor families and also has held an awareness campaign to aware the people of the locality about the virus and how to keep themselves protected against it.

## ➤ SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Skill development is important to sustain in today's world as well as become self-reliant and self-employed. Most of the



companies/industries today demands skilled manpower for growth of the companies/industries. Our organization provides Skill Development education to the people especially the youth. This year also we

provided skill development training to the people throughout the year and also felicitated the meritorious students with certificate.

## ➤ PROVIDE WORK FOR THE WORKLESS COMMUNITY

Unemployment is a big issue in India and it causes



significant impact on our economy as well as the mental health and wellness of those who are unemployed. This needs to be cured. Our organization, in this year, has

organized placement camp programme in association with managers of different reputed companies who conducted interview and selected eligible candidates for their company.



## ➤ EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME

Education is an essential prerequisite for growth and



modernization of our country. It shapes our future. But due to lack of financial and other problems, many poor children as well as youths lack

proper education. Our organization has helped many people by providing them educational programmes, skill training, coaching classes etc.

## ➤ MEDICAL SERVICES

Our organization has also provided medical services like



Medical Check-up Camps, Emergency Ambulance Services, Health Awareness Camps etc. during the year 2020-21 at several places in

Kolkata and nearby rural areas which has helped thousands of people in need.

## ➤ NURSING TRAINING INSTITUTE

Our organization has established a nursing training institute where we provide Nursing Training to thousands of people (especially women) at reasonable cost (or at no cost



depending upon the financial situation of the candidate) every year. We also provided a certificate of completion to them after they have successfully completed the training programme and passed the final exam conducted by us in a proper manner.

### ➤ WOMEN AND CHILD PROTECTION

Women play a very important role in our household as well as in several other fields. They are our mother, sister,



daughter and wife and always guide us and stands beside us in case of any trouble. In today's time, women are and making us proud in several

fields that were once male dominated. But still there are some places or regions where women are not given the importance and support that they deserve. Our organization has arranged several programmes for women like motivational seminars, skill training programme etc. so that they get the help and support that they deserves.

Also children are the future of our country. But there are some areas where children don't get proper guidance and



support in order to make their future bright. Our organization has also arranged several educational programmes for them where they can learn new things and grow. We also protect women and child from any kind of bad situation like domestic violence, malnutrition etc.

### ➤ NATURAL CALAMITIES AND DISASTERS RELIEF PROGRAMME
